# The Southworth Library Volunteers

**Traveling Books:** These volunteers travel to day care facilities with a bag of books for preschoolers every other week. They read a few books to the children and leave the books for the day care provider to use until the next visit when they bring a new bag. We currently serve eight different locations in the Dryden area.

**Willowbrook Senior Housing:** We provide books and materials for the residents who find it difficult to get to the library. Every four weeks we select new titles to bring over and pick up the ones that are there.

**Annual Book Sale:** volunteers sort through the donated materials for the sale, transport them and help to set them up at the sale each year. This is a huge undertaking that requires lots of hands on help!

**Library service Assistant:** This include shelving books after they have been returned or processed, shelf reading to make sure things have been put back correctly, book repair and processing. Youth program assistants help with children and teen programs in preparation or the events themselves. Greeters answer basic questions about the library and help people find what they are looking for

**Internet Trainer:** Provide assistance for people to use the internet for their information needs and to help them with basic internet and software use.

**Special Programs:** Help with teen, children and general programs for special events.
