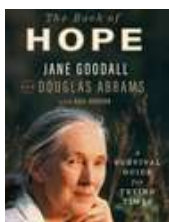

By: Sarina Bowen

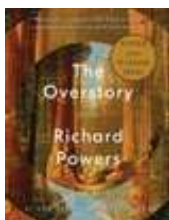

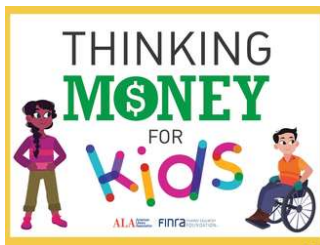
Thinking Money: Game Time for Kids!
