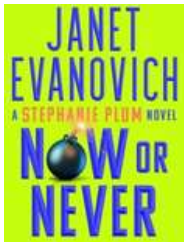

A winter getaway turns deadly in this tale of relationships and the struggles of middle age.

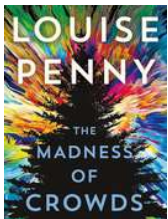
