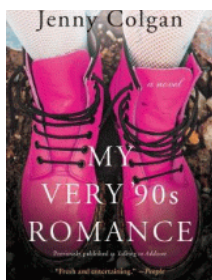

Grab a pint and share a book that you've read about love and romance this month. Check out the display at the library for ideas of books to check out. All are welcome! Bring a dish to share if you like.



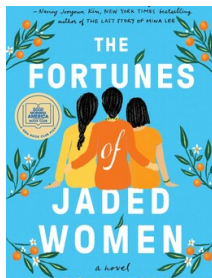

Receive a free copy or bring a book of your own and enjoy some snacks and quiet reading time.

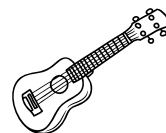
