

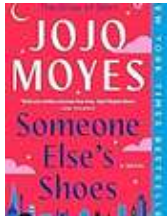

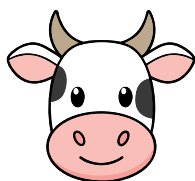


Jennie's Book Club

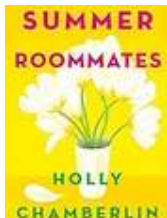


Books & Brew

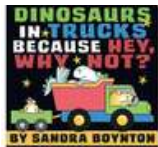
